

As we are sensible of your and Clans fidelity and in loyalty to us during our adventures in Scotland and England in the year 1745 and 1746 in recovering our just rights from the Elector of Hanover, by which you you have sustained very great losses both in your interest and person, I therefore promise when it shall please God to put it in my power to make a greatful return suitable to your suferings
