

*The following ORDER is published by Authority.*

WHEREAS it is necessary, for preserving the Regularity of our Army, that all Volunteers that have or may offer their Service to us, join themselves to some Regiment of Foot or Horse, or Train of Artillery, so that they may be mustered, paid, and do Duty alongst with them; We therefore hereby order all the said Volunteers already in our Service, to join as aforesaid, within forty eight Hours after the Publication hereof, and such as shall hereafter offer their Service to us, are to join as aforesaid within forty eight Hours after their Arrival at our Army. And we hereby prohibite and discharge, under our highest Displeasure, any Person or Persons to wear Cockades, unless they be joined as said is, or belong to the Conductors of our Baggage, Forage, Provisions, Houshold, or other Branch of our Service. Given at our Palace of *Holy-rood-house* the twenty second Day of *October* 1745.
